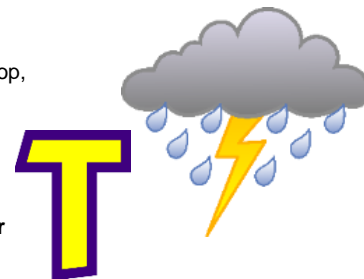
Count on Math: Patterning
