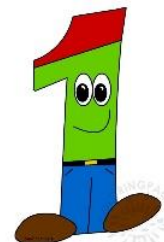

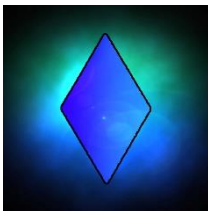

...work our small motor skills by washing in water center

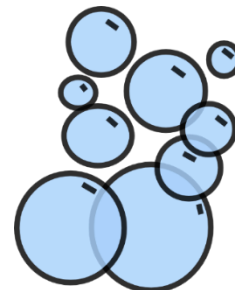
