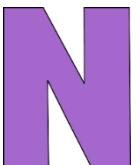

...create with crayons & so much more

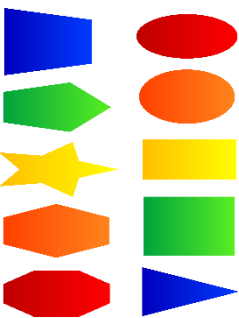
